<p>ORDER ON REMAND FROM COURT OF APPEALS 99CA1033</p>	

THIS MATTER is on remand to the Board of Assessment Appeals after entry of the Supreme Court’s decision on Case Nos. 00SC417, 00SC579, 00SC580, 00SC581. The Supreme Court affirmed four separate Court of Appeals’ judgments. The Court of Appeals reversed the action of the Board of Assessment Appeals with directions to deny taxpayer’s exemption claims and to reinstate the total valuation of the subject property as set by the Denver County Board of Equalization for the 1998 tax year.

ORDER:

The Respondent is ordered to reinstate the value of the subject personal property at \$934,384.00 for tax year 1998.

The Denver County Assessor is directed to change his records accordingly.

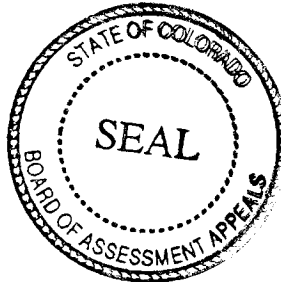
