Petitioner's request for withdrawal is granted; therefore, the Board will take no further action on this matter.

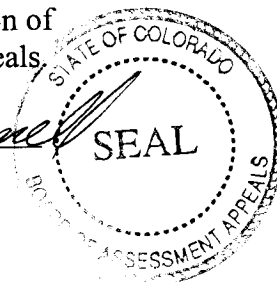


