6. The valuations, as established above, shall be binding only with respect to tax year 2004.


7. Brief narrative as to why the reduction was made:

The subject property originally was assigned an allocated value after review uniform market rates were applied in a revised income approach.


8. A hearing has not been scheduled before the Board of Assessment Appeals.
