

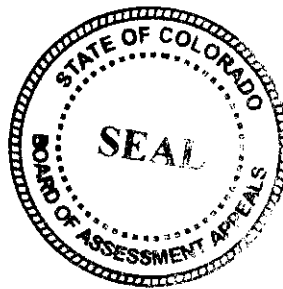

STIPULATION (AS TO TAX YEAR 2005 ACTUAL VALUE)

The Petitioner(s) and Respondent agree and stipulate as follows:

1. The property subject to this Stipulation is described as:

2. The subject property is classified as residential apartment complex property.
3. The County Assessor originally assigned the following actual value on the subject property for tax year 2005.

4. After appeal to the Denver County Board of Equalization, the Denver County Board of Equalization valued the subject property as follows:

5. After further review and negotiation, the Petitioner and Denver County Board of Equalization agree to the following actual value for the subject property for tax year 2005.

6. The valuations, as established above, shall be binding only with respect to tax year 2005.

7. Brief narrative as to why the reduction was made:

Additional weight was given to the petitioner's market approach via a 2004 MAI appraisal.

8. Both parties agree that the hearing scheduled before the Board of Assessment Appeals on December 6th, 2007 at 8:30am be vacated.
