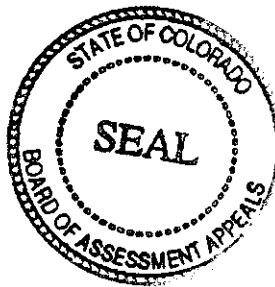


Further review of appropriate market sales resulted in a reduced value estimate.


8. Both parties agree that the hearing scheduled before the Board of Assessment Appeals will be vacated.
