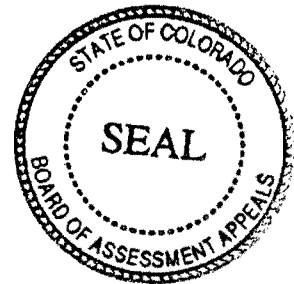

3. The County Assessor originally assigned the following actual value to the subject property for tax year 2009:

Agricultural land	\$5915.00
Improved Commercial Land	\$40,930.00
Commercial Improvements	\$69,953,155.00
Total	\$70,000,000.00

4. After a timely appeal to the Board of Equalization, the Board of Equalization valued the subject property as follows:

Agricultural land	\$5915.00
Improved Commercial Land	\$40,930.00
Commercial Improvements	\$69,953,155.00
Total	\$70,000,000.00

5. After further review and negotiation, the Petitioner and the County Board of Equalization agree to the following tax year 2009 actual value for the subject property:

Agricultural land	\$5915.00
Improved Commercial Land	\$40,930.00
Commercial Improvements	\$59,953,155.00
Total	\$60,000,000.00

6. The valuation, as established above, shall be binding for tax year 2009 and tax year 2010.

7. Brief narrative as to why the reduction was made: Both parties have contacted an expert witness to appraise the property, and have taken into account prior appraisals and prior negotiated settlements. The parties agreed to accept a negotiated valuation amount, taking into account the valuations discussed with expert witnesses and prior settlements.

8. No hearing date has been scheduled in this matter.

9. Both parties agree that the Board of Assessment of Appeals shall enter an Order as stated above in this Stipulation.




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
