The parties have agreed that the 2013/2014 actual value of the subject property should be reduced as follows:



Both parties agree that the hearing before the Board of Assessment Appeals be vacated or is unnecessary if one has not yet been scheduled. Petitioner(s) agree to waive the right to any further appeal of 1973-28-3-15-001 for the assessment year(s) covered by this Stipulation. Respondent reserves the right to account for any value added or subtracted by any 'unusual conditions' that may have occurred between 1/1/2013 and 1/1/2014. **Petitioner does not waive the right to dispute any value added or subtracted by any 'unusual condition' so accounted for by the Assessor.**

Both parties agree that (no interest) or (interest in the amount of \$0.00) shall be paid by the county to the petitioner in this matter and that the petitioner waives any and all other rights to recover (any) or (additional) interest.
